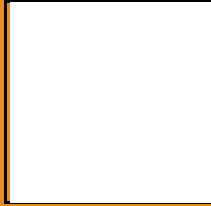

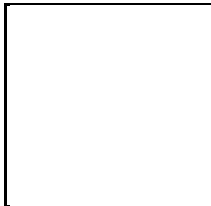

As one of the recruitment advisors for Sigma Epsilon I wanted to inform the Austin alumnae of some very important information regarding recruitment at both our local chapter and nationally. First, the University of Texas is NO LONGER PARTICIPATING IN SUMMER RECRUITMENT. If you know anyone who is going through recruitment at the University of Texas please make them aware of this!!! In

years past when potential new members would attend orientation, chapters would contact the girls in order to take the girls to dinner, invite them swimming, etc but this is no longer the case. Please let future collegians know so they are not disappointed when they are not contacted. The university is prohibiting any communication other than the organized panhellenic events during orientation. There will be a Panhellenic table where PNMs can ask general questions about recruitment and going greek as well as a "Go Greek" info session. Please encourage any ladies you know going through recruitment to attend both of these events. If you have any questions or concerns please contact the Panhellenic coordinator at the University of Texas. Second, at the Sigma Epsilon a reference is REQUIRED for the lady to receive a bid and you can find these forms on the 24/7 filing cabinet. There are only a handful of KD chapters across the nation that still require a reference form, but there are benefits to providing one regardless of the requirement.
