



Kappa Delta Sorority National Council Application Conflict of Interest Statement

Conflict of Interest is defined as follows:

When a member of an organization has a real, potential, or perceived personal interest that may influence her when making decisions for the organization. One's personal interests may not conflict with the organization's interests. Members are obligated to honor this standard with regard to all decisions and actions and those who do not may be subjected to civil and even criminal charges.

Examples:

With respect to those seeking a Kappa Delta National Council position, an appearance of, or actual, Conflict of Interest may arise in the following circumstances:

- A candidate or her supporters attempt to unduly or inappropriately influence the vote of other voting delegates, especially if the voting delegate is a collegian who may be overly influenced by an alumna member.
- A voting delegate is influenced to make decisions based upon personal alliances rather than exercising her duty to serve the best interests of the organization.

Accordingly, candidates for a National Council position should not participate in such activities, and should make every attempt to discourage others from participating in such activities.
