

**KAPPA DELTA SORORITY**  
**Undergraduate Scholarships Offered for the 2012-2013 Academic Year**

**FOUNDERS' SCHOLARSHIPS:** Each year four (4) scholarships of \$4000 (over two semesters) each are awarded to collegiate members of Kappa Delta Sorority. Since 1972 these scholarships have been awarded on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**ELIZABETH BANTA MUELLER SCHOLARSHIPS:** These three (3) \$2,000 scholarships were endowed by the late Elizabeth Banta Mueller, Lambda chapter, Northwestern University, a former member of Kappa Delta's National Council and Hall of Honor recipient. Two will be awarded to collegiate members of Kappa Delta majoring in the fields of speech/communications. The third will be awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta pursuing the career of her choice. All three are awarded based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

**GRAYCE CHASE SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship was established by a bequest from Grayce Chase, an initiate of Phi chapter, University of California at Berkeley. The scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**GRACE FOLLMER SCHOLARSHIP and HELEN FOLLMER LUTZ SCHOLARSHIP:** These two (2) \$2,000 scholarships were established by a bequest from two sisters, Grace Follmer and Helen Follmer Lutz, both initiates of Phi Tau chapter, Bucknell University. Each scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**M. AMANDA GORDON SCHOLARSHIPS:** These three (3) \$2,000 scholarships were established by a bequest from Amanda Gordon, an initiate of Epsilon Omega chapter, University of Kentucky. Each scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**MARILYN MOCK SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship was established by a bequest from Marilyn Mock, an initiate of Beta Epsilon chapter, University of Tulsa. The scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**REED & GLORIA PENINGTON SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship is given by Patricia Penington Brickel, an initiate of Beta Xi chapter, University of Colorado, in honor of her parents. It will be awarded to a Kappa Delta collegian who is majoring in the fields of journalism or communications and will be awarded based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

**DOROTHY RAMAGE SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship was established by a bequest from Dorothy Ramage, an initiate of Alpha Iota chapter, University of California-Los Angeles. The scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**JEAN TUCKER STRADLEY SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship is given by Jean Tucker Stradley, Pi chapter, University of Nebraska, former National President. It will be awarded to a Kappa Delta collegian enrolled in the College of Education, majoring in elementary education, and working toward a baccalaureate in Education. The award is based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

**MARION DAY MULLINS SCHOLARSHIP:** This scholarship was established in honor of Marion Day Mullins, Sigma chapter, Gunston Hall, former National President and Hall of Honor recipient by the National Council. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta who is majoring in the field of business (accounting, economics, finance, marketing, etc.) and is based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

**MARGARET BUDD HAEMER SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship is endowed by Lawrence F. Haemer in memory of his wife, Margaret Budd Haemer, a 1938 initiate of Beta Beta chapter, Brooklyn College. The scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**MURIEL JOHNSTONE SCHOLARSHIPS:** These three (3) \$2,000 scholarships were established in 1998 from funds received from the Estate of Muriel Johnstone, Alpha Pi chapter, College of William & Mary. Each scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university. *Financial need will also be a consideration in the awarding of this scholarship. Chapter Advisor must confirm financial need.*

**ERNESTINE L. NEWMAN SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship was established to honor the memory of Ernestine L. Newman, a 1932 initiate of Alpha Rho chapter, University of Maryland. This scholarship is awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

**PAM BARTON STAPLES SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 scholarship is endowed by Pam Barton Staples, a 1966 initiate of Gamma Zeta chapter, Texas Christian University. This scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member who shall have attained junior or senior class status; who has served her college panhellenic association with distinction, demonstrating the true spirit of panhellenism in her chapter; and who has a 3.0 grade point average on all college work. Letters from the chapter president and an advisor supporting the panhellenic service must be included with the application.

**ERMA METZ BROWN SCHOLARSHIPS:** These two (2) \$2,000 scholarships are endowed by Erma Metz Brown, a 1940 initiate of Theta Sigma, University of Southern California. Each scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member who is majoring in elementary education and will be awarded based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

**SIGMA BETA CHAPTER-UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$1,000 scholarship is given by the alumnae of Sigma Beta chapter, University of Minnesota to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta with junior or senior status and a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. It is awarded based on academic excellence, Kappa Delta leadership, and university and community involvement. This scholarship is awarded biennially, each Convention year.

**RUTH ROUSE DOLBERG SCHOLARSHIP (new):** This \$2,500 scholarship is made possible from a bequest of Jean Tucker Stradley, Pi chapter, University of Nebraska, former National President to honor former National Treasurer Ruth Rouse Dolberg. It will be awarded to a Kappa Delta collegian working toward a degree of Bachelor of Science and Business Administration with a major in Accounting. The award is based on academic performance and service to chapter and university.

## **REGIONAL/CHAPTER SPECIFIC:**

*The following scholarships are awarded to collegians from specific chapters or a particular area.*

### **Pennsylvania Keystone Scholarship**

**KEYSTONE SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$1,000 will be awarded to a collegiate member of Xi, Alpha Phi, Beta Theta, Beta Upsilon, Eta Theta and Eta Lambda chapters of Kappa Delta who is enrolled as a full time undergraduate student at a Pennsylvania university, who has an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and who has demonstrated outstanding academic performance, as well as service and leadership in her chapter, university and/or community.

### **Gamma Delta**

**LOUISE DUBOSE SELLS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** This scholarship was established to honor the late Louise DuBose Sells, a 1928 initiate of Gamma chapter, Hollins. A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member of Gamma Delta chapter on the basis of academic excellence, service to Gamma Delta chapter and East Tennessee State University.

### **Sigma Iota**

**HELEN LAWRENCE GRYGIEL SCHOLARSHIP:** Established in 1997, this \$2,000 scholarship is endowed by Vada May Lawrence Corkery in memory of her sister, Helen Lawrence Grygiel, both initiates of Sigma Iota chapter, University of Washington. The scholarship is awarded to a member of Sigma Iota chapter and is based on academic performance and service to university and community.

### **Sigma Pi**

**EILEEN G. SRODES SCHOLARSHIP:** These two (2) \$500 scholarships were established in 1996 by a bequest from Eileen G. Srodes, a 1929 initiate of Sigma Pi chapter, Albion College. Each scholarship is awarded to an initiated member of Sigma Pi chapter who is a full-time student entering her third or fourth year at Albion College, and on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

### **Sigma Upsilon**

**MYRTLE MAE COMER-LOY SIGMA UPSILON SCHOLARSHIP:** Established in 1997, this \$2,000 scholarship endowed by the late Myrtle Mae Comer-Loy, a 1925 initiate of Sigma Upsilon chapter, Indiana University, will be awarded to an initiated member of Sigma Upsilon chapter who is a full-time student entering her second, third or fourth year at Indiana University, and on the basis of academic excellence and service to chapter and university.

### **Texas University**

**TEXAS KAPPA DELTA ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$1,000 scholarship is given by the Texas Kappa Delta Alumnae Associations. It will be awarded to a collegiate member of Kappa Delta who is enrolled as a full time undergraduate student at a Texas university, who has an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and who has demonstrated outstanding academic performance, as well as service and leadership in her chapter, university and/or community.

### **Sigma Tau**

**SARAH DAVIES KRAVIK SCHOLARSHIP:** Established in 2001, this \$2,000 scholarship is endowed by Sigma Tau House Corporation in memory of Sarah Davies Kravik, 1925 initiate of Sigma Tau chapter, Washington State University. This scholarship is awarded to a member of Sigma Tau chapter and is based on campus, Greek, and Kappa Delta leadership and involvement, with a strong emphasis on academic excellence.

### **Eta Alpha**

**SUZANNE HASLANGER DRIEVER SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$500 scholarship was established in 2001 to honor the late Suzanne Haslanger Driever, a 1960 initiate of Beta Mu chapter, Bowling Green State University. This scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member of Eta Alpha chapter on the basis of academic excellence, service to Eta Alpha Chapter and Texas A&M/College Station.

### **Alpha Chi**

**MARY ATKINS HANNA SCHOLARSHIP:** Mary Atkins Hanna was initiate #1 of Alpha Chi chapter at Louisiana Tech University in 1931. Throughout her life, she continued to serve Kappa Delta as an active member of her Shreveport Alumnae Association, and her interest in and enthusiasm for the collegiate members of Alpha Chi chapter remained strong. Mary's #1 badge was donated to the chapter and is proudly displayed in the chapter's lodge, along with the badge of the local sorority that became Alpha Chi chapter of Kappa Delta. This \$2,000 scholarship was established with a bequest to the Kappa Delta Foundation by Mary Hanna along with memorial donations from many friends and family members.

The recipient shall be a collegiate member of Alpha Chi chapter. An applicant must possess a 3.2 cumulative grade point average on 50 hours or more earned credit and must be returning to Louisiana Tech in the fall. The recipient will be chosen based on Kappa Delta leadership, campus and community involvement, and letters of recommendation.

### **Sigma Epsilon**

**ALBERTA E. SCOTT SCHOLARSHIP:** This \$2,000 endowed scholarship was established in 2002 by a bequest from Alberta E. Scott, a 1927 initiate of Sigma Epsilon chapter, University of Texas. This scholarship is awarded to an initiated member of Sigma Epsilon chapter who will be classified as a junior at the beginning of the new academic year and has demonstrated unusual commitment to her chapter through service on committees and in appointed and/or elected offices. Her grade point average must be at least a 2.5 and her dedication to Kappa Delta must in every way reflect the high level of respect, dedication, and love Alberta Scott demonstrated for her sorority throughout her life.

### **Beta Tau**

**ROSE-MARIE GARCIA ANDERSON BETA TAU SCHOLARSHIP:** **Two (2)** scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each are endowed by Rose-Marie Garcia Anderson, a 1944 initiate of Eta chapter, Hunter College. These scholarships will be awarded to collegiate members of Beta Tau chapter on the basis of academic excellence, service to Beta Tau and Vanderbilt University, and community.

### **Gamma Nu**

**ROSE-MARIE GARCIA ANDERSON GAMMA NU SCHOLARSHIP:** **Two (2)** scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 each are endowed by Rose-Marie Garcia Anderson, a 1944 initiate of Eta chapter, Hunter College. These scholarships will be awarded to collegiate members of Gamma Nu chapter on the basis of academic excellence, service to Gamma Nu and Miami University, and community.

### **Sigma Kappa**

**FRANK & VIOLET KOKEN SCHOLARSHIP:** Established in 2007, this \$2,000 scholarship is endowed by J. Patricia KoKen Merrill, a 1945 initiate of Sigma Kappa chapter, Ohio State University, and former National President, in honor of her parents. This scholarship will be awarded to a collegiate member of Sigma Kappa chapter with a grade point average of 3.25 or higher, and on the basis of academic excellence, service to Sigma Kappa chapter and Ohio State University.

### **Beta Pi**

**BETTE CHISHOLM RIKER SCHOLARSHIP:** Established in 2009, this \$2,000 scholarship largely endowed by Bette Chisholm Riker, a 1948 initiate of Beta Pi chapter, University of Florida, and other contributors, will be awarded to a collegiate member of Beta Pi chapter on the basis of academic excellence, service to Beta Pi chapter, the University of Florida, and the community.

### **Pi**

**JEAN TUCKER STRADLEY-PI CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP: (new)** This \$2,500 scholarship is made possible from a bequest of Jean Tucker Stradley, Pi chapter, University of Nebraska, former National President. It will be awarded to a collegiate member of Pi chapter, University of Nebraska. This award is also based on academic performance and service to Pi chapter and university.
